Guidelines for Abstract Submissions

Presenters and Posters will be selected based on the quality of work or research related to biological, engineering, environmental, training or policy issues associated with wildlife, aircraft and airports. The Conference Program Committee will review the abstracts and set the program components.

How to Submit

- Complete the Presenter/Poster Submission Form
- The form is available on the website at www.birdstrikecanada.com
- All information **MUST** be typed on the form.
- Save form as a word document Save it under the presenters last name then first name.
Example: Dove_Carla.doc
- E-mail form to Vanessa Ong. In the RE: box put 2009 BSNAC Abstract then your last name and first name.

Preparing the Abstract

A good abstract should briefly tell

- What problem you addressed and why
- How you did the investigation
- Your results
- What your results mean
- Focus on the most important findings, positive or negative
- Be quantitative and descriptive (e.g., body densities averaged 11-29% higher for starlings than for 3 species of gulls) as opposed to indicative (e.g., gulls and starlings had different body densities).
- Make the title descriptive of the main topic but concise

Deadline for Submission: March 16, 2009
Notification of Acceptance: April 30, 2009

Please note - upon receipt of acceptance for presenters, papers will be due by August 15, 2009. Papers must be in electronic format. pdf is the preferred format. We will also accept MSWord doc or text file. Papers will be published on the website. www.birdstrikecanada.com
